Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter dated 03.06.2016 accepting the conditions contained in Ministry's letter dated 30.05.2016, furnishing an undertaking and to convey the formal permission of the Central Government to Midnapore Medical College, Midnapore for increase of intake capacity in MBBS course from 100 to 150 seats from the academic year 2016-17 under Section 10(A) of the IMC Act, 1956.

2. This permission of the Central Government is accorded initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to the verification of the achievement of annual targets as indicated in your scheme. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the increased capacity of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed and a formal recognition of Medical College against increased intake is granted.
3. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for all India quota.
4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under IMC Act, 1956 & Regulations made thereunder will be initiated.
5. Discrepancies, if any, may be brought to the Notice of MCI and Central/State Government.
