In continuation this Ministry's letter of even number dated 5.2.2004 and with reference to your letter dated 13.3.2004 , I am directed to convey the approval of the Central Government for the establishment of a new medical college in the name and style of “ Midnapore Medical College & Hospital” at Midnapore by Govt. of West Bengal with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred only) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic session 2004-05 under section 10(A) of IMC Act, 1956 as amended.


2. This permission of the Central Govt. for establishment of the college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievement of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India. The college shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission. The college shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievement in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipment as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as required by Medical Council of India norms must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Central Government.

3. The admission process for the academic year 2004-05 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997 (as amended) and in any case no admissions shall be permissible after 30<sup>th</sup> September, 2004.




